<p>ELIGIBILITY</p>	<p>TRAINING INSTITUTION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any athletes from a local/international school gymnastics program and private clubs are welcome to participate in the Diamond Classic Event. • All participating athletes must be accompanied by a coach who is named on the registration form. • All participating athletes must be entered under a school or club team. • An athlete can enter as an individual as long as they are representing a club or school. • Please Note: We do not accept individual registrations from parents that are not affiliated with a club or school.
<p>EVENT FORMAT</p>	<p>Individual Competition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual All Around (IAA) • Apparatus Finals <p>Team Competition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum team size for team competition: minimum 3, max of 8 (more than 8 can be entered in a level but only up to 8 may be designated for the team category) • Maximum one team per club for each competition category • Combination of top 3 scores of each club/school on each event, across all apparatus, per level, per age group • Every Club that has 3 or more athletes (per level), will automatically be entered into the team competition. • Team competition will only be held if there's a minimum of 3 teams per category. • There will be ONE team per level, no junior or senior age categories.

	<p>Best Performance Awards (BPA)</p> <p>Medals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual All Around (IAA) - Medal awarded to places 1-3 Ribbons 4-6 • Individual Apparatus Winners - Medal awarded to places 1-3 <p>Team Awards</p> <p>Trophy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Team trophies are awarded to the top 3 performing teams for the level category • Depending on the total number of teams entered for the junior and senior categories in each level, team awards will be separated into junior and senior categories.
<p>AGE CUT OFF</p>	<p>Age categories are based on the age the athlete is as of the 31st of December 2026</p>
<p>AGE CATEGORIES</p>	<p>The competition will be determining the age categories by equally and fairly dividing the athletes entered into smaller age groups.</p> <p>Each athlete will receive an A, B, C, etc. age group after the entries are closed.</p> <p>Coaches do not need to designate junior or senior on their entry, rather the athlete is entered in by their level only.</p>
